*Overview of public comments on bicycle and pedestrian improvements*

At this time, the City of Austin bicycle bridge TIP amendment has the highest public comment favorability. Annick has continued to receive positive responses.

2. STP-MM Bike/Ped Applications Accepted Until October 31, 2007

*Leroy Click (Travis County) found an error in the Excel application, which has been fixed. Greg will answer questions on the call for projects, if any*

There were several questions regarding the applicability of funding, which Greg answered:

- Right-of-way must be established, or written confirmation of acquisition before the scheduled project for each bike/ped application.
- Agency in-kind contributions can serve toward the added points in section E2: Cost Participation, but cannot be used to meet the minimum 20% local match.
- Planning and engineering costs can be included in the project costs, in addition to construction.
- There have been a few questions regarding the dates needed at the beginning of the applications. “Receive Notification Letter” refers to notification letter of the project being awarded funding. We have tentatively scheduled Policy Board consideration for March 2008, so the earliest this could happen is April, 2008. “Obtain Environmental Clearance” refers to whichever process is applicable to your project. Project management staff should determine whether an Environmental Assessment, Environmental Impact Statement, or none of the above will be required for the project, which may not be possible to determine until the preliminary study is complete.

3. Other Business

Annick introduced Nadia as a new employee of Public Works, who will be responsible for their STP-MM application, among other tasks.
