Presentation and Discussion:

1. Walk For A Day Trail

Butch Smith, of the Hill Country Conservancy will present the Walk For A Day Trail concept for consideration in "People, Planning and Preparing for the Future: Your 25 year Transportation Plan".

Mr. Smith described the project in general as starting at the Barton Creek Greenway and connecting a series of public and private land south to Hays County. The project is expected to serve multiple trail user types with a variety of materials likely to include concrete, granite gravel, and natural surfaces. Natural surface portions are anticipated to be built according to International Mountain Biking Association (IMBA) standards. He submits the project on behalf of the Hill Country Conservancy for consideration in the next metropolitan transportation plan.

Greg Griffin will provide a brief update of current steps in the process of "People, Planning and Preparing for the Future: Your 25 year Transportation Plan".

G. Griffin updated the committee with latest public involvement and technical efforts on the metropolitan transportation plan (memo attached).
