## Population and Employment Forecasts Approved



The five counties in the Austin-Round Rock metropolitan statistical area are projected to reach 3.25 million people in the year 2035. The CAMPO Policy Board recently approved the [population and employment forecasts](#) for Williamson, Travis, Hays, Caldwell and Bastrop counties. Over the next several years, planners in the CAMPO region will work together to plan a 2035 transportation system based on these forecasts.

## CAMPO's Policy Board Undergoes Membership Change



On April 9<sup>th</sup>, a restructured [CAMPO Policy Board](#) met for the first time. Reduced from its previous size of 23, the Policy Board now has 18 members representing cities and counties in Williamson, Travis and Hays Counties, agencies providing transportation services and members of the Texas Legislature ([Membership makeup](#)). The most significant change in the membership is a reduction in the number of members of the Texas Legislature (10 to 3) and an increase in smaller city representatives.
