

CAMPO received **four responses to the RFP**. The evaluation committee evaluated the submissions according to the criteria above. Based on the scores of the written submittals, the evaluation committee **invited two firms to participate in interviews**, provide an oral presentation and answer project related questions.

Staff requests the TPB authorize the CAMPO Executive Director to negotiate and execute a contract with the top ranked consultant firm to manage the Regional TDM Program.















